

CENTRE ADVANCEMENT CAMPAIGN GOAL REACHED

KITCHENER WATERLOO STRATFORD PERTH, ONTARIO: The Humane Society of Kitchener Waterloo & Stratford Perth (HSKWSP) reached its fundraising goal in order to purchase a new x-ray machine and to build & improve onsite parks for shelter dogs.

“We wanted to raise, in addition to the funds required for our day-to-day operations another \$100,000 for improvements to our centres.” said Nick Burke, Director of Development at HSKWSP. “Now that we have reached our financial goal, we can begin the work on our dog parks in both centres and continue preparing our hospital for our new x-ray machine! Upgrades to our veterinary clinic will allow us to complete thorough x-ray imaging for every animal that needs a dental procedure. Improvements to our outdoor facilities will provide safe and exciting areas for our animals to exercise and play. These updates will also give our volunteers a safer environment while they provide enrichment for the animals in our care.”
