Humane Society Hosts Virtual Puppy Shower To Raise Funds For Panda and her 13 Puppies

KITCHENER & STRATFORD, ONTARIO: The Humane Society of Kitchener Waterloo & Stratford Perth (HSKWSP) is hosting a virtual puppy shower to celebrate and raise funds for 13 puppies that were recently born into their care.

Four-year-old, pregnant Panda arrived at the centre on March 8. A quick ultrasound revealed she would be a mum to at least 12-14 puppies. Panda went into labour on April 18 and welcomed a litter of 14 adorable puppies – seven boys and seven girls – after almost eight hours in labour. Sadly, the smallest of Panda’s litter did not survive, but the remaining 13 puppies are healthy and thriving.

“We are overjoyed with the arrival of these adorable puppies! As always, we are committed to providing them with the best possible care,” stated Kathrin Delutis, chief executive officer, HSKWSP. “Being a self-funded and self-governed organization that receives no government funding for our charitable programs and services, we rely on our community’s generosity to provide this life-saving care. We truly hope you’ll donate today in the way that works best for you.”

Panda and her puppies will remain in foster care until they are old enough and ready for adoption.
